8th Aachen Run for Peace – Germany

The **Aachen Run for Peace** is supported and organized by 8 peace organizations: Pax Christi in the Diocese of Aachen, Aachen Peace Prize, Forum of Civilian Peace Service, network of Aachen Schools against Violence and Racism, the Rheinland Protestant Community of Students, Federation of German Catholic Youth Association of Diocesan Aachen, Mission, DJK-Sports Association and Amnesty International.

Pax Christi - as the main organizer of the run - is a Catholic peace organization, dealing foremost with peace education and reconciliation within different ethnic groups and peoples in more than 60 countries.

The subject of the “8th Aachen Run for Peace” was “Run for diversity – against Violence and Racism”. With the donations amounting to about EU 50'000 - the organizers supported the work of numerous peace organisations.

The special sponsored run encourages children and young people to advocate self-confidently for peace and reconciliation and the colourful togetherness of people with different backgrounds.

More than 4'200 children and young people from 37 local schools participated. They formulated their inner attitude as follows: “We want to live in a colourful, diverse and tolerant city in which all people have the same rights and can live without fear.”

The preceding accompanying peace educational programme, lasting several weeks and consisting of theatre by the pantomime “Scheibub”, anti-violence-training, creative workshops etc.- reached more than 1'500 school-children promoting their self-perception and the perception of others and to sensitize them to peace and peaceful conflict resolutions.

In the meantime the Aachen Run for Peace is also carried out in Augsburg, Berlin, Bonn, Bremen, Freiburg, Hamburg and as well in Bosnia and Macedonia.
